



EWS2: Training Series on Understanding and Provision of Palliative Care to Patient and their Carers 2024

Course information:

EWS2: The training series on understanding and provision of palliative care to patients and their carers consists of three sessions: (Session 1) An introduction on palliative care concept, pain and symptoms management of patient with terminal illness, supporting dying at home and palliative care. (Session 2) Discussion on advance care planning and advance directives, care for imminently dying patient, and providing bereavement support. (Session 3) Introduction to the three instruments of peace (平安三寶) and an understanding about how they offer protection to the needs of the elderly.

Speakers:

Dr. Chen Wai Tsan Tracy is a palliative specialist in medicine. She has been serving in this field since 2000. She is currently the consultant at Haven of Hope Sister Annie Skau Holistic Care Centre. Additionally, she has been the team leader of the Jockey Club End-of-life Community Care Project “Hospice at Home” of the Centre since 2016, supporting terminally ill patients at home. Apart from her clinical duties, Dr. Chen actively promotes life and death education to health care professionals and the public through her contributions as the Chairman of Society for Life and Death Education, and as a council member of the Hong Kong Society of Palliative Medicine and Comfort Care Concern Group.

Ms. Angelina Luk is a Solicitor, a notary public and a former adjunct professor of the Law Faculty of the University of Hong Kong. Her latest Chinese book 《贏在終點線 (修訂版)》 (Winning at the Finish Line) explains in layman terms the Wills, Enduring Powers of Attorney and Advance Directives in relation to Medical Treatment, collectively “the 3 Instruments of Peace (平安三寶)”, as well as probate law and practice in Hong Kong. She has delivered more than 80 talks on the 3 Instruments of Peace in almost all of the 18 districts in Hong Kong. She also serves on the following committees: the Working Party on Enduring Powers of Attorney of the Law Society; and Advisory Board of the Centre for Positive Aging and the Cadenza Hub, co-founder and director of MEC Academy Limited.

Ms. Ko Po Shan Polly, is an Ex-Nurse Consultant (Palliative Care), KEC, Hong Kong Hospital Authority. She has extensive clinical experience in palliative care nursing. Her expertise in palliative care is exemplified by her dedication to provide continuity of palliative care support to patient and their families, bridging care from hospital settings to home care services, and collaborating effectively with multidisciplinary team in the community.
